Liberating Structure 1-2-4-All

Sequence of Steps and Time Allocation

- Silent self-reflection by individuals on a question/topic 1 min.
- Generate ideas in pairs, building on ideas from self-reflection. 2 min.
- Share and develop ideas from your pair in foursomes (notice similarities and differences). 4 min.
- “What is one item/idea that stood out in your conversation?” Each group shares one important idea with all (repeat cycle as needed). 5 min.
